About the Program:

The Centre for Projection Art's Artist in Residence program provides selected artists with resources and support to explore projection in their contemporary art practice.

A mentor is paired with the artist for the duration of the program, they are encouraged to explore, experiment and work responsively to grow their concepts in new directions.

Selected artists for the Artist in Residence program will be supported by an honorarium (\$1,000 TBC).

Program Criteria to Consider:

- Contemporary visual artists working in any medium are eligible to apply
- Emerging to mid-career artists
- A demonstrated interest in pursuing a project that features new media art and expanded considerations of projection art
- Applications are open to individual artists and artist pairs/duos
- This program will be delivered onsite (Collingwood Yards) & online

What to Prepare for EOI Submission:

- Documentation of artworks (images or video)
- CV
- Short bio
